White:

- Orsett Beauty: 3" pure white ball flowers
- White Aster: 1-2" pure white pompon flowers, originally introduced in 1879!
- Bride to Be: 4" classic waterlily blooms
- Lainie White: 4" pure white ball flowers

Orange:

- Kasasagi: 1-2" pompons, petals are yellow in the center fading to red at the edge
- Andrew Charles: 5" informal decorative golden orange blooms, delicate petals
- Maarn: 2-3" tangerine colored balls on a more compact plant
- Azteca: 5" informal decorative blooms blend from golden yellow to orange, pointed petals

Yellow

- Day Dreamer: 4" waterlily blooms in soft yellow blending to apricot
- **Moonstruck**: 3" informal decorative type blooms in a lovely soft yellow, pointed petals. Early.
- **Starburst spice**: 5" pointed blooms like a firework: yellow in the center and red at the petal tips.
- Crazy legs: 3" Stellar style blooms, petals are bronzed yellow on top and rusty red on reverse

Red

- Karma Chocolate: 3-4" deep, chocolaty red waterlily type blooms. Dark foliage.
- Red Dinnerplate: 6" decorative blooms in a gorgeous, saturated, burgundy red.
- Mirella: 2-3" ball dahlia in a glowing, coppery, orange-red
- **Totally Tangerine**: Unique 3" anemone type blooms have a dark red pompom center lined with a ring of peach petals
- **Dark Butterfly**: 2" deep red blooms have almost a waterlily shape but smaller than most.

Purple

- **Crème de Cassis**: unique 3-4" decorative 2-tone blooms. A dusky lavender on the front and darker purple on the back of the petals, with a dark center to the bloom. Shorter plant.
- Midnight Moon: 4" formal decorative, pristine white fading to lavender on each petal.
- Koko Puff: 1-2" pompon in an unusual smoky lavender color

Pink

- **Colorful Investment**: 4-6" fuschia colored decorative blooms, very productive.
- Tami's Coral: 4" decorative blooms fading from coral to apricot. One of my favorites.
- Fur Elise: 3-4" decorative blooms ranging from peach to salmon to coral
